Interesting Facts:

Last time out Iowa State snapped a two-game losing skid, by pulling out a 68-62 win at Colorado.

Since we left for break the Twister Sisters have had a 6-2 record. With wins coming against Northern Iowa (76-51), North Carolina A&T (66-62), Fairfield (67-37), Lafayette College (67-25), South Dakota (68-43), and Colorado (68-62). The two losses came to Big 12 opponents Nebraska (49-57) and Texas A&M (44-68).

Senior Alison Lacey was unstoppable for ISU, scoring a season-high 32 points, including a stretch of 18 straight points for ISU in the second half. She also pulled down eight rebounds, had four assists and did not commit a turnover. Lacey was 10-of-15 from the field, 4-of-6 from long range, and 8-for-8 from the line in only 30 minutes of playing time.

The Jayhawks are led by Danielle McCray who averages 20.9 points per game and they will also be without starting Freshman point guard Angel Goodrich, who tore her right ACL last week against Oklahoma State.
